Last year Mt Vernon High School piloted a parent registration system and now the rest of Mt Vernon schools will be participating.

Whether it is about safety, rumors, academics, activities, school newsletters, superintendent updates or other vital information that parents need to know, we have designed a simple program for you to use.

We are eager to have maximum parent participation so we need you to invest a few minutes of your time by registering at each school where you have a child attending. (parents who have already registered on the high school site do not have to re-register at this time . If you are not registered there, please do so.)

Here's what you need to do:

If you have a child attending MVMS, MVIS, MCE, MES, or FES, please log on to that school website and click on "parent registration system". The link is located on the left side of each buildings website. This will take you to the registration page.

You must log on separately to each school where you have children attending. If you have more than one child at a school, you will only have to go there once.

Click the blue "register now" button, enter your email address and begin the process. Once you provide some basic information, you will select as many subgroups in which your student is a member. (some schools have more than others)

Sign up for those items and proceed to the "complete registration" process.

Each person in your family who wants to receive the updates needs to register with a separate email address.

Your information can be updated by you at any time by logging back in with your email and password. This will be important as more subgroups are added to the various school sites.
