Age to enter school

On or before **August 31, 2016** students must be **5 years old to attend kindergarten** and on or before **August 31, 2016** students must be **6 years old to attend first grade**. (Students with August birthdays will also need to fill out the "Application for Early Enrollment in Kindergarten or First Grade" in addition to the enrollment application.)

SPECIAL NOTE: It is important that we have all Kindergarten students register before the end of the 2015-2016 school year to prepare the number of teachers that will be needed to keep class size low. If you have any questions please feel free to contact the school (see information below).

**You may register at any of the three sites for all three schools.
Please let the site know which school you will be attending.**

What to bring:

- Student (they will be screened for vision, hearing and abilities)
- Copy of birth certificate
- Copy of immunization records (requirements on the back)
- Proof of residency (bill with your name and address on it)
- Driver's license or Identification Card
- Copy of Court papers if there is any Custody information
- IEP (if applicable)
- **Mt. Vernon Enrollment Application or Transfer Student Application** (if out of district). This can be filled out before you come in to save time. (Students with August birthdays will also need to fill out the "Application for Early Enrollment in Kindergarten or First Grade" found on the "Enrollment Forms" page.)

School Immunization Requirements
Updated November 2015

Hep B The minimum age for the 3rd dose of Hepatitis B is 24 weeks of age.

DTaP Four doses of DTaP/DTP/DT are acceptable if 4th dose was administered on or after child's 4th birthday.

Polio Three doses of Polio are acceptable for all grade levels if the third dose was given on or after the 4th birthday and at least 6 months after the previous dose with only one type of vaccine used (all OPV or all IPV). For students in grades kindergarten through 6th grade the final dose must be administered on or after the 4th birthday, and be administered **at least 6 months** after the previous dose.

Live Vaccines (MMR, Varicella & LAIV) Live vaccines that are not administered on the same day must be administered a minimum of 28 days apart. The second dose should be repeated if the doses are separated by less than 28 days.

Varicella Physician documentation of disease history, including month and year, is proof of immunity for children entering preschool through 8th grade. Parental report of disease history is acceptable for grades 9-12.

Tdap There is no minimum interval from the last Td dose.

MCV4 Individuals who receive dose 1 on or after their 16th birthday only need 1 dose of MCV4.

Hep A The minimum interval between 1st and 2nd dose of Hepatitis A is 6 calendar months

For children who have delayed immunizations, please refer to the 2016 CDC "Catch-up Immunization Schedule" to determine adequately immunizing doses. All minimum intervals and ages for each vaccination as specified per 2016 CDC guidelines must be met for a dose to be valid.
