ELEMENTARY SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM GRADES K-5

(open to all Fortville Elementary, McCordsville Elementary & Mt. Comfort Elementary current K-5th grade students)

REGISTRATION PACKET

Mt. Vernon Community School District is offering a summer school program for elementary school students in grades first through fifth. Remediation and Enrichment will be provided in the content areas of reading, language arts, and mathematics.

GOAL: To Remediate and Enrich MVCSC elementary students during a summer power semester.

WHO CAN ATTEND: All MVCSC elementary students currently enrolled in grades kindergarten through fifth who wish to attend a power semester of remediation and/or enrichment.

WHERE WILL CLASSES BE LOCATED: Classes will be held at Fortville Elementary School, 8414 N. 200 W. Fortville, IN 46040. (317)-485-3180.

WHAT SUBJECTS WILL BE TAUGHT: All students will receive instruction in reading, language arts and mathematics. The summer school staff will provide a program based on student needs and designed to provide remediation and enrichment of specific skills sets.

WHAT WILL BE THE CLASS SIZE: The number of students in each class will be 15-20. A certified, highly qualified teacher will be assigned to each class.

WHEN WILL STUDENTS ATTEND: Summer school will run for two weeks beginning June 6, 2016, and ending June 17, 2016. Classes will be held from 8:30 a.m. until 11:30, Monday through Friday.

WHAT IS THE COST: There is no cost to the student.

WHAT RULES AND REGULATIONS APPLY: The rules and regulations which apply during the regular school year apply during summer school. Parents and students should refer to the Student/Parent Handbook and Discipline Code as it relates to discipline matters. It is expected that all children will behave in a manner that will not be disruptive to other students. Violations of other rules which require suspension during the regular school year will be grounds for summer school dismissal as well.

HOW CAN I REGISTER MY CHILD FOR SUMMER SCHOOL: Registration packets are available at each school and online at www.mvcsc.k12.in.us Complete the attached registration packet and return it to your student's school front office on or before **May 6, 2016**. It is very important that parents register their children as soon as possible and have the school complete all information in order for the summer school staff to provide a program to meet the needs of each student.

TIMES: The Elementary Summer School Program begins on June 6, 2016 and will continue for ten (10) instructional days, Monday - Friday, through June 17, 2016. Students should be in class and ready to work from 8:30 a.m. until 11:30. Students are expected to be on time. Students may bring a light snack from home such as chips or crackers, and they may bring a water bottle only. No other drinks will be allowed. **Please choose a snack from the Treat List found in the Student Handbook. Snacks must be peanut Free! NO BREAKFAST OR LUNCH WILL BE OFFERED**

TRANSPORTATION: Transportation will be provided from centrally located bus stops to Fortville Elementary for summer school. Morning pick-up times will be approximately 8:00 a.m. with return times at approximately 12:00-12:15 p.m. Students may not be dropped off until the bus arrives. Parents/Guardians must be prompt and report to their designated schools bus loading zone for pickup and drop-off.

Pick-up locations: Mt. Comfort Elementary School, McCordsville Elementary School, and Memorial Park in Fortville

CAR RIDER INFORMATION: Students are to be dropped off and picked up only at the North entrance of Fortville Elementary. Students may not be dropped off prior to 8:15 a.m. Student dismissal is 11:30 a.m. and should be picked up no later than 11:45 p.m.

ATTENDANCE: Parents/Guardians are urged to encourage their student to attend summer school every day and to be on time. This will allow the student to receive the most benefit from participating in the summer school program. Please refrain from scheduling appointments or vacations that would interfere with the daily class schedule.

DRESS CODE: Students' attire must comply with the MVCSC dress code as stated in the 2015-16 Student/Parent Handbook.
