Age to enter school

On or before **September 1, 2017** students must be **5 years old** to attend kindergarten and on or before **September 1, 2017** students must be **6 years old** to attend first grade.

SPECIAL NOTE: It is important that we have all Kindergarten students register before the end of this school year to prepare the number of teachers that will be needed to keep class size low. If you have any questions please feel free to contact the school (see information below).

You may register at any of the three sites for all three schools. Please let them know which school you will be attending.

What to bring:

Student (they will be screened for vision, hearing and abilities)
Copy of birth certificate
Copy of immunization records (requirements on the back)
Proof of residency (bill with your name and address on it)
Driver's license or Identification Card
Social Security Card/Number
Copy of Court papers if there is any Custody information
IEP (if applicable)

Hep B Two dose alternative adolescent schedule (Recombivax HB® given at age 11-15 years x 2 doses) is acceptable if properly documented.

DTaP Four doses of DTaP/DTP/DT are acceptable if 4th dose was administered on or after child's fourth birthday.

Polio Three doses of polio vaccine are acceptable if 3rd dose was administered on or after child's fourth birthday and the doses are all IPV or OPV. *The 4th dose of polio vaccine must be administered on or after child's fourth birthday. This applies only to kindergarten, 1st, 2nd and 3rd grades for 2013-2014 and beyond.

MMR If given as single antigen, 2 Measles, 2 Mumps and 1 Rubella required.

Varicella Physician documentation of disease history, including month and year, is proof of immunity for children entering preschool through 5th grade. A signed statement from the parent/guardian indicating history of disease, including month and year is required for children in grades 6-12.

Tdap A Tdap booster can be given as early as 1 year after a Td vaccination.

MCV4 One dose is required. Two doses are recommended for grades 11 & 12. Individuals who receive dose 1 after their 16th birthday
