

*	Renovation of the Current Administration Building	\$2,000,000


Option 3:

Impact of All Potential Projects








Virtual Town Hall Meetings - December 3 and 9



On a scale of 1-5, how supportive are you of the proposed options to accommodate projected enrollment growth, with '1' being not supportive to '5' being highly supportive?


