Keeping your student immunized is important to your child's health and required by the Mt. Vernon Community School Corporation. The Hancock County Health Department provides thousands of immunizations each year to students all over Hancock County.

The Hancock County Health Department is partnering with the Mt. Vernon Community School Corporation to provide the required and recommended vaccinations.

## Immunizations offered at this clinic:

- **Hepatitis A** - new state required for grades K-7th grade students
- **Gardasil (HPV9)** - recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
- **Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)** - required for 6th grade students
- **Meningococcal (MCV4)** - required for 6th grade students

Immunizations will be ran through parent/guardian health insurance. If no health insurance, student will still be able to receive immunizations.
