# Kindergarten Registration

Register your student for Kindergarten at ANY of these three sites for any of the three schools.

## Registration Dates and Locations:

Monday, April 8th, noon - 7 p.m. - McCordsville Elementary School

Tuesday, April 9th, noon - 7 p.m. - Fortville Elementary School

Thursday, April 11th, noon - 7 p.m. - Mt. Comfort Elementary School

While at registration, be sure to enroll your child in the **Hancock County Promise**. Register for a **FREE CollegeChoice 529 Direct Account** and **receive up to \$50** for your child's account!

On or before August 1, 2019 students must be 5 years old to attend kindergarten.

## What to Bring:

- Student (they will be screened for vision, hearing, and academic skills)
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of Immunization Records (list of requirements is on the next page)
- Proof of Residency (Utility Bill, Mortgage Statement, HUD Statement, Lease Agreement)
- Parent/Guardian Driver's Licence or State Issued Identification Card
- Copy of Court Papers (if there is any pertinent custody information)
- Student's Individual Education Plan (IEP) (if applicable)

## How to Enroll a Kindergartner for the 2019-2020 School Year:

- Attend one of the Kindergarten Registration dates with your child & bring required documents.
- To make the process quicker, the **online portion** of kindergarten registration will be **open after April 5**. Attendance is still necessary at the registration events.
  - **New in-district Mt. Vernon families** can register their kindergarten student for next year after April 5th by visiting the New Student Online Enrollment at <https://bit.ly/2Uj7VcD>.
  - **Current Mt. Vernon families** wishing to register a new kindergarten student should log into their Skyward Family Access and click on the "New Student Online Enrollment" tab.

## Indiana 2019-20 Required and Recommended School Immunizations

Number next to vaccine denotes the number of cumulative doses needed.

**Hep B:** The minimum age for the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose of Hepatitis B is 24 weeks of age.

**DTaP:** 4 doses of DTaP/DTP/DT are acceptable if 4<sup>th</sup> dose was administered on or after child's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.

**Polio\*:** 3 doses of Polio are acceptable for all grade levels if the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose was given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and at least 6 months after the previous dose.

\*For students in grades K-9, the final dose must be administered on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and be administered at least 6 months after the previous dose.

**Varicella:** Physician documentation of disease history, including month and year, is proof of immunity for children entering preschool through 11<sup>th</sup> grade. Parent report of disease history is acceptable for grade 12.

**Tdap:** There is no minimum interval from the last Td dose.

**MCV4:** Individuals who receive dose 1 on or after the 16<sup>th</sup> birthday only need 1 dose of MCV4.

**Hep A:** The minimum interval between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose is 6 calendar months. 2 doses are required for grades K-7 and 12. For Pre-K and grades 8-11, 2 doses of Hep A are recommended.
